The local/state component will be 25 percent of the required hours for each certification level. The Bureau of EMS and Preparedness has created this guideline document for agencies to use. The agency will be able to determine the actual needs of their staff and adjust these hours as needed. If an agency adjusts the hour requirement it must be uniform for all providers. Emergency vehicle operations cannot be used to satisfy this requirement.
